## 2026 UPDATE

### Summary

The Arizona Association of County Engineers (AACE) continues its longstanding focus on technical exchange through its Annual Meeting and Esterbrooks Awards and either hosted or promoted workshops. AACE held its Annual Meeting on January 22-23, 2026 which realized a very strong turnout of over 84 attendees and exhibitors. The Meeting started with keynote presentation by the Director of the Arizona Department of Transportation and featured a strong technical program on project delivery and technical applications for roads and bridges. A Meeting hallmark includes presentations by every County Engineer on projects and activities in their county; it makes for instant connection and information exchange for interested consultants and contractors not to mention collaboration among County Engineers on delivering similar projects.

The Chapter is rebooting is popular AACE/NACE Western Region Conference, June 10 – 12, 2026 in Laughlin, Nevada. The Conference will feature sessions under pavement and operations themes and include county engineer roundtable discussions.
